



COVID19 Temporary Family Behavior Agreement

In order to reopen we do need to establish new policies, and require certain procedures and behaviors from the families that will be using care between our reopen date and June 30th (unless this general re-open date of June 30th changes due to state or local authority). I, _____, parent of _____ wish to begin attending the (circle one) O Street N Street location, effective _____. The following list is true for my family:

- I will sanitize my hands immediately upon entry and before touching the sign-in books and other school items
- I will bring my own pen for signing in and out
- I will wear a mask at drop off and pick up
- All parties that may be responsible for dropping off and picking up my child will adhere to these guidelines
- I will attempt whenever possible to make the drop off and pick up person consistent to reduce exposure from more people
- I will not bring unnecessary items into the centers. This includes the storing of car seats and strollers
- I will bring my child by 9 am daily (this is to ensure we have staffing for daily health checks)
- I will call ahead of picking up so my child will be ready, to reduce contact with other families and staff members
- I will not enter the classrooms, except for preauthorized circumstances as defined by the Center Director
- If I bring my child, it is because everyone in our home is healthy and symptom free, with no known exposure to COVID19
- I will wait for my child to be screened for signs of illness daily
- Fever reducers will not be given to my child on any day of attendance, regardless of reason for fever reducer
- If my child shows signs of illness during care, I, or an authorized representative, will retrieve my child within 30 minutes or sooner whenever possible
- I will wait my turn to enter the facility, and practice proper social distancing while on school premises. If there is someone being screened and no room for social distancing, I will wait outside until there is space for me to safely enter the facility entryway
- I will thoroughly wash my and my child's hands before drop off, prior to picking up, and as soon as we return home
- I will not bring extra people onto school premises when dropping off or picking up
- I will follow new stricter guidelines for cubby contents-one change of clothing, one blanket, one sheet, and I will not allow my child to bring items from home onto school premises
- Water cups will be brought daily, after being cleaned at home. Infant bottles must be lidded and labeled, and will still go home daily for sanitizing and refilling
- I understand this situation is fluid and subject to state and local authority revision
- I understand failure to follow these new safety guidelines may result in termination
